

“Genesis” COVID-19 Guidance

STAY ALERT > CONTROL THE VIRUS > SAVE LIVES

Prior to your trip

A COVID-19 risk assessment has been completed for your trip aboard “Genesis” and will be regularly updated as and when new information regarding the COVID-19 virus is received.

“Genesis” will have been cleaned and sanitized prior to your arrival onboard. You will be asked to wash your hands with hand sanitizing gel (provided) prior to boarding “Genesis”.


Social Distancing

A maximum number of 6 clients will be allowed on the vessel in order to comply with the Welsh Government restrictions on Social Distancing.

The enclosed area of the wheelhouse of “Genesis” will be **Out of Bounds** to all clients during the charter with no option to store personal items or equipment. Please ensure that you have a weatherproof bag to store your personal belongings.

Where possible, you should try to maintain 2 metres distance between each person onboard. Signage will give a visual reminder with **red circles** on the gunwales to indicate each person’s position to maintain 2 metre separation.

Angling Positions are shown below:



It is inevitable that on certain occasions, persons will not be able to maintain a social distance of 2 metres. However, you are requested to do everything practical to manage the transmission risk by:

1. Keeping the activity time involved as short as possible.
2. Using face masks and gloves.
3. Using back to back or side to side working/passing whenever possible.
4. Reducing the number of persons you have contact with.

Personal Protection Equipment

All clients are advised to bring their own Personal Protection Equipment (PPE) if possible. These should be worn at all times when in close proximity (<2m) of another person. Face masks, sanitizing gel & wipes will be provided for use on board.

Hand sanitizing gel is available onboard however, all personnel are advised to bring their own.

Virus Spread Prevention

To reduce the spread of germs when you cough or sneeze, cover your mouth and nose with a tissue, or your sleeve (not your hands) if you don’t have a tissue. Put any used tissues in the provided black bin bag immediately. Finally, wash your hands using hand sanitizing gel.

Be mindful that when the vessel is in transit, anyone positioned downwind & behind someone else will be directly in the flow of exhaled air from the person in front, thereby increasing the potential risk of infection.

Toilet

The onboard toilet should only be used for urinating. If it is absolutely necessary to defecate then you should wipe the toilet seat with disinfectant wipes prior and post use of the toilet. Only dispose of used wipes in the bag provided in the toilet. Do not attempt to flush them.

Please advise the skipper once the toilet has been used so that it may be sanitized prior to next use.

Angling

All anglers should bring their own rods, end tackle and bait. Anglers should also be prepared to land and unhook their own fish. The Skipper will offer assistance only with large fish, whilst observing social distancing.

Rod hire will be available however, end tackle will not be fitted or supplied.

Disembarkation

All clients are kindly requested to clean their own personal area and take any rubbish with them when leaving the vessel. A bin is available at the pontoon entrance.

Please disembark observing social distancing.
